Time is running out before the full implementation of the new Medical Device Regulations in 2020 with their requirements for enhanced Clinical Evaluation Reports (CER) to support CE registration or renewal (MEDDEV 2.4/1 rev 4, 2016). Creating and maintaining appropriate CER's across a wide portfolio of medical devices requires both time and expertise. A typical CER may take up to 3 months to complete and draw upon technical skills of literature appraisal and interpretation of clinical data. Development of this skill set in-house may be problematic with a scarcity of experienced literature reviewers. Outsourcing the creation, and maintenance, of your CER's to an organization such as the Welsh Wound Innovation Centre may be one solution to help you meet this challenge.
